



General Information

Purpose: Braided River Quilters are dedicated to the appreciation and enjoyment of quilting and to the friendship bonds forged through participation and sharing the art and the craft of quilt making.

Meetings: Meeting shall be held on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm at a predetermined location. Doors will open at 6:00pm. The business year will be August through May; there will be no meetings in December, June or July.

Guests: Any person temporarily residing (less than one year) with a guild member may attend meetings with that member as a guest. All other guests are limited to two meetings.

Show and Tell: Show and Tell is the member's opportunity to share their quilts, quilted projects, old quilts, quilts in the making, or any other quilt-related item. Each member inspires other members.

Programs: The Vice President and the program committee will determine the interest of the membership and schedule programs accordingly. The emphasis is on fun and learning.

Quilt Show: The membership will decide whether or not to have quilt shows or displays.

Newsletter: One newsletter will be sent to each member. That newsletter will be sent prior to the August meeting which is the first meeting of the business year.

Dues: The Early Bird rate for annual dues shall be \$25 if paid before May 31 of each year. The Regular rate for annual dues shall be \$35 if paid after May 31 and are not pro-rated.
