The International Quilt Museum

The International Quilt Museum celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2022. As always, this world-class museum has six galleries or exhibit areas, with exhibits changing at least twice a year. Exhibits hang for anywhere from 2 months (for the smaller exhibit areas) to 6 months (for the larger galleries).

Please check the website to determine the opening days, times, and what exhibits are in place before traveling to Lincoln.

Now Showing at the International Quilt Museum

Layered & Stitched: 50 Years of Innovative Art May 5 - December 16, 2023 *West Gallery*

The International Quilt Museums is pleased to feature a showcase of art quilt history developed by the Studio Art Quilt Associates. Layered & Stitched: 50 Years of Innovative Art showcases 50 art quilts by renowned master artists. Seminal works show the evolution of the art quilt from the earliest pioneers creating during the 1960s through to today’s artists experimenting with new forms, new materials, and new digital technologies.

Trace the development of this exciting art form as it developed from isolated makers into an international movement involving thousands of artists spanning the globe.

At a Premium: Tobacciana in the Late-Nineteenth and Early-Twentieth Centuries April 12 - September 16, 2023 *Pumphrey Family Gallery*

Cigarette silks, cigar silks, and tobacco flannels were all collectible items collectively referred to as “Tobacciana,” and were used as marketing tools by tobacco companies. Women used these pieces of decorative fabric to create pillow covers and quilts. Greta Mikkelsen is a quilt artist who takes loose tobacco premiums and creates new quilts with them, honoring the original practice. These new quilts will be shown alongside original objects to give dimension to an initially short-lived quilting trend.

Art Market is November 17 – 18, 2023. Admission is free that day, and come to see various vendor artists and the great bargains – quilt related, antiques, sewing items – at the Friends of the IQM table. Funds raised go to the expenses at the IQM – staffing and educational purposes.

Free events at the museum each month is First Friday – from 4:30 to 7:00. A speaker or entertainment is provided, and galleries are open for viewing.

Placemaking: Quilts and the Creation of Special Spaces April 7 - September 30, 2023 *Gottsch Gallery*

For geographers and other social scientists, place is not simply a physical location. The concept of place includes both tangible and intangible characteristics, and it reflects the ever-changing nature of a geographical area. For instance, a neighborhood is not only composed of buildings, streets, and people, but also of:

These spaces are enhanced by the cloth’s: Texture ... materials ... imagery ... workmanship ... and beauty

NSQG Grant

In an effort to promote quilting, the Nebraska State Quilt Guild will provide financial grants to Nebraska quilt guilds wishing to sponsor a quilt event. We want to encourage guild members to create new ways to build interest in quilting. A committee has been formed to consider all applications. Twice a year, the Grant Committee will choose guilds to receive this financial help. Application deadlines are January 1 and June 1. Applicants will receive a response from the Grant Committee by January 30 and June 30.

In your own words, tell us about your event idea. Please include the points listed below:

1. An applicant must be an NSQG member in good standing. (current year NSQG dues paid)
2. The event must be educational and promote the art of quilting in Nebraska
3. The event must be open to the public.
4. A budget for you event must be provided
5. Please state the dollar amount you are requesting from NSQG. This grant is not intended for events already funded by NSQG. (Please note NSQG reserves the right to decide the amount awarded)
6. Proposed time and location of the event

Other requirements include:

- NSQG must be named as a sponsor of the event
- Photos of the event and copies of advertising must be provided to the Grant Committee
- If the event is canceled for any reason, the money given by NSQG must be returned

Grilled Chicken Pesto Panini



- 4 boneless skinless chicken breasts, and pounded thin
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon fresh minced garlic
- 1 tablespoon dried Italian seasoning
- salt and pepper
- 1 1/2 cups roasted red peppers (bottled or canned)
- 4 slices provolone cheese (sliced thick)
- 1/2 - 3/4 cup pesto sauce (bottled or homemade)
- 8 slices Italian bread (sliced 1/2-inch thick, can use about 4 x 4-inch ciabatta rolls in place of the Italian bread)
- olive oil, for brushing on bread

DIRECTIONS

Pound the chicken fillets until thin between two pieces of waxed paper, then marinate in oil, garlic, pepper and Italian seasoning for about 1-1/2 hours.

Heat a grill pan or sauté pan (the breasts can also be grilled on the BBQ).

Season the breasts with salt and pepper.

Cook the chicken on medium heat for about 5 minutes per side, or until golden and cooked through.

Remove from pan and place on a plate or board.

Top each fillet with some of the roasted peppers and a slice of cheese.

Spread BOTH sides of the bread with pesto sauce.

Place chicken inside the bread and form to a sandwich.

Brush both sides of the outside of bread with olive oil.

Heat a grill pan or a 10-inch skillet on medium high heat. Place the panini in the pan (only 2 at a time).

Weigh the panini down with another heavy skillet and then top with a heavy can (a very large can of tomato juice works great for this!) cook for about 3 minutes, or until bread is toasted.

Turn the panini, and weigh it down again with a heavy skillet and a can on top, and toast for another 3 minutes.

Remove from pan and cut in half.

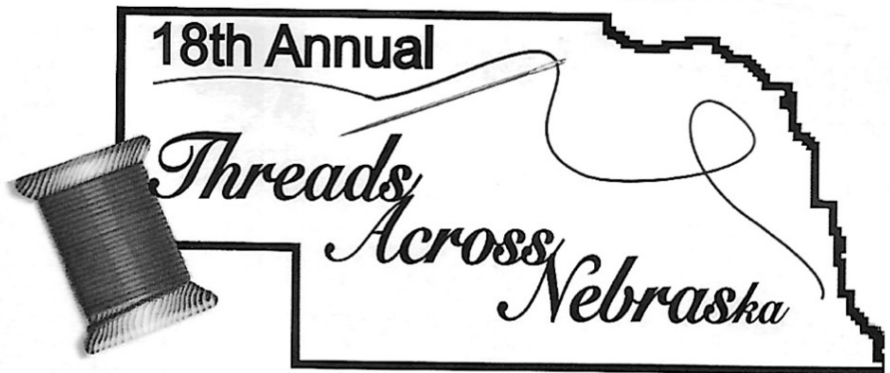

Classes are described in another article. The cost of these classes will be \$25 for a 90-minute class, \$30 for a 2 hr class and \$35 for a 3 hr class. The admission fee will be paid when class registration is paid. If you are taking class on Friday and Saturday, the admission fee needs to be paid for both days. Upon registration, each person will receive a pass that gets them into the show.
